THE HOSPITAL

Harris Regional Hospital, established in 1929, is an 86 – bed acute and specialty care facility serving a primary service area of the western North Carolina counties of Jackson, Swain, Graham and Macon as well as parts of North Georgia. In the last several years, Harris Regional Hospital was named Top Performer on Key Quality Measures by The Joint Commission for performance on the measure sets of heart failure, pneumonia and surgical care. The ranking placed Harris Regional Hospital in the top one-third of Joint Commission-accredited organizations in the nation.

Harris Regional Hospital's major service lines include Women's and Children's Care, Orthopedics and Sports Medicine, Cardiology, Emergency Medicine and multi-specialty outpatient and ancillary care.

Harris Regional Hospital is privileged to provide care that is recognized on state and national levels:

- Designation as a 4-Star Breastfeeding Friendly facility by the North Carolina Maternity Center
- Recognition by the March of Dimes for reducing to less than one percent the number of elective inductions and cesarean deliveries performed before 39 weeks of pregnancy
- Staff caring for mothers and babies at the New Generations Family Birthing Center at Harris Regional Hospital were presented with the hospital's Blue Ribbon Award for receiving the organization's highest patient satisfaction scores during a recent measurement period

SWAIN COMMUNITY HOSPITAL THE HOSPITAL

Swain Community Hospital, established in 1950 as Swain County Hospital, is a 48-bed Critical Access Hospital serving Swain and Graham counties. Emergency medicine and primary care are supported by on-site ancillary services such as imaging, laboratory, and physical and occupational therapy, sleep lab, and pain center. Specialty rotations including pulmonology, and orthopedics and sports medicine occur throughout the week enhancing greater access to care while limiting patients' travel to other facilities for subspecialist care. A pain clinic operated by the hospital and led by a fellowship-trained pain management physician serves patients on the hospital campus.

A family practice located inside the hospital has a medical staff of three Physicians, a pediatrician, and two mid-level providers seeing adults and children five days a week. The emergency department provides care for 11,000 people per year.

SYLVA, NC HOME TO HARRIS REGIONAL HOSPITAL

Sylva, NC, home to Harris Regional Hospital and Bryson City, NC, home to Swain Community Hospital, perfectly capture the “small town America” lifestyle that residents know and love, while being situated in easily-drivable proximity to several cities. A mere 30 –minute drive from both the Georgia and Tennessee borders. Sylva and Bryson City boast easy access to major airports, an array of recreational activities, and a thriving local retail and restaurant scene, all while offering residents the opportunity to live in a small-town life within beautiful mountain scenery.

THE COMMUNITY

Located 50 minutes west of Asheville, NC Jackson County was founded in 1851 and named for U.S. president Andrew Jackson. The county’s population topped 40,000 according to the 2010 census and has experienced a 22% increase in population since the mid-2000s. Sylva, home to Harris Regional Hospital, is nestled among the surrounding Great Smokey Mountains with elevations ranging from 2,000 feet to more than 6,000 feet. The town of Sylva features a quaint and thriving downtown area, offering an array of locally-owned restaurants, many of which feature vegetarian and Vegan options. In addition to being less than an hour from Asheville, Sylva is also convenient to upstate South Carolina and less than three hours from Charlotte, North Carolina’s largest city.

Jackson County is also home to Western Carolina University, located in Cullowhee, just ten minutes from the heart of Sylva. WCU is a popular and thriving university providing an education to more than 10,000 students in undergraduate and graduate programs. Southwestern Community College, which offers competitive programs including the region’s only radiologic technologist program, has garnered national rankings for best community colleges and is located in Sylva.

Sylva and the surrounding towns of Dillsboro, Cullowhee, Cashiers, and Highlands are known for their proximity to nature and an array of readily-accessible outdoor activities. The Tuckasegee River flows 40 miles throughout Jackson County and provides opportunities for beginner and family whitewater rafting and is considered one of western North Carolina’s best trout streams. The landscape is highlighted by waterfalls, rocky peaks and the Great Smokey Mountains National Park, providing opportunities for hiking and biking throughout the region. There are active wellness initiatives in Jackson County including opportunities to join group exercise events, as well as healthy eating and lifestyle programs which are in place in partnership with the hospital and community organizations. The county features updated recreational parks and venues for physical activities and sports.

Western Carolina University, which is part of the University of North Carolina system, boasts an award-winning fine arts department, offering outstanding theater and music shows throughout the year, all of which are open to the public. The university is a viable competitor in athletics, taking home championship titles in basketball and baseball, with opportunities to see games throughout the year. In addition, WCU’s “Pride of the Mountains” marching band performs at home football games and has won competitions on the national level. Harris Regional Hospital and Swain Community Hospital are the official Health System partner of Western Carolina Athletics.

BRYSON CITY, NC HOME TO SWAIN COMMUNITY HOSPITAL

THE COMMUNITY

Located 25 minutes west of Sylva and 75 minutes west of Asheville, Bryson City is the county seat of Swain County which has an overall population of 14,500. Bryson City borders the Great Smokey Mountains National Park and provides several entrances to the park in addition to a multitude of outdoor recreation opportunities. Landmarks surrounding Bryson City include the Cherokee Indian Reservation, Nantahala River/ Nantahala Gorge, Fontana Lake and Fontana Dam. A picturesque and memorable downtown features a one-of-a-kind shopping and dining experiences as well as Great Smokey Mountains Railroad. Southwestern Community College, which has attained national rankings for best community colleges, has a campus in Swain County, just west of Bryson City.

As a gateway to the Great Smokey Mountains National Park, Swain County features miles of hiking and biking trails as well as nearby campsites and horseback riding opportunities. River surrounding the area include the Nantahala, Tuckasegee and Oconaluftee, all of which provide recreational and fishing options. Bryson City is known for whitewater rafting and offers a variety of outfitters providing guided rafting, kayaking and canoeing trips. The acclaimed Nantahala Outdoor Center is located just 20 minutes from downtown Bryson City and offers world-class paddling instruction, whitewater rafting on the Nantahala River as well as other regional rivers, bike rental and guided tours, lodging, shopping, dining, and more. The nearby Tsali Recreation Area trail system has a reputation for some of the best bike trails in the region.
